Trinity Youth Chorus

The Trinity Youth Chorus consists of children from Manhattan and the New York metropolitan area, and provides a unique musical environment for young singers. A collective of community choirs, the chorus offers music education and performance opportunities for girls and boys, ages 5-18.



Newark Boys Concert Chorus

The NBCS Concert Chorus is a renowned performing group, comprised of students in grades 6-8. The chorus has a diverse repertoire including folk songs, classical, spirituals, show tunes, pop, and jazz. They perform at venues throughout the state & tour internationally every third year. Travel includes Japan, Australia, South Africa, Russia, China, New Zealand, Finland, England and Wales.

The Hunterdon Youth Choir has performed state-wide in youth festivals, concerts and benefits for local charities for more than 10 years. The choir has grown over the years, and will be featuring their **Bel Canto Singers** (women in grade 7 and up) for this special musical event.



A workshop preceding the concert will provide the opportunity for the three choirs to practice together and get to know each other. This is an important musical and cultural event, because it brings together three outstanding youth choirs that have been of great importance to their respective communities.

Tickets are \$15 for adults and \$10 for children and seniors. A reception will immediately follow the concert.
