Voices For Charity Invites Charities to Apply for 2005

Periodically, *Voices For Charity* opens the door for new charities to apply to become one of a limited number of non-profit organizations that *Voices For Charity* will dedicate their efforts to helping. In order to qualify for consideration, each organization must:

- be an IRS 501(c)(3) tax-exempt non-profit organization;
- serve or benefit the Hunterdon County or surrounding area; and
- be willing to complete an application process that includes a detailed description of their agency, mission statement, services provided, how their funds are allocated and intended use of potential funds donated.

In order to be considered, each charity must submit a letter of request by October 1st to be considered for the following year. Proof of 501(c)(3) status and a description of the organization must accompany the request.

Voices For Charity will send out applications to all requesting and qualified non-profit agencies on or before October 10th. Applications must be completed and returned by November 10th. Decisions and notification will be made to those charities that have been chosen by mid-December for the following year.
